

Important Information

1. **Fees:** 2010-2011 registration fees and completed forms, plus any outstanding fees from previous years, must be received from each skater before they are allowed on the ice surface. **The Club will only accept payment by cheque.**

2. **Skate Canada Fees:** All registered skaters and Program assistants must pay the annual Skate Canada Registration fee which includes insurance coverage for each skater. This fee is included in the PreSchool, CanSkate, Adult, and PowerSkating fees listed in this brochure.

3. **Refunds:** There will be no refunds after 1st November (or February 1st for January, 2010 registrants). Requests for refunds must be made in writing and sent to the President. Skate Canada fees are not refundable. An administration fee of \$25 will be charged.

4. **NSF cheques:** A fee of \$25 per cheque is charged.

5. **Discounts:** Families of three or more skaters will receive a 10% discount.

6. **Volunteer fees:** \$100 per family for skaters in, PreSchool, Canskate &/or Adult; \$150 per family for skaters in STARskate post dated to April 1st, 2011. Upon completion of volunteer hours, the cheque is returned to you/destroyed.

7. **Volunteer hours:** 5 hr minimum per family for PreSchool, CanSkate, and Adult; 10 hr minimum per family for STARskate.

8. STARskate qualifications:

Junior: working on Preliminary Tests.

Intermediate: passed Junior Bronze Dance tests or Preliminary Free Skate or Preliminary Skills or Introductory Interpretive.

Senior: passed Senior Bronze Dance tests or Junior Bronze Free Skate or Junior Bronze Skills or Bronze Interpretive.

9. **Cancellation of Programs:** The club reserves the right to cancel any program with insufficient registrants.

10. **Ice Show Practices:** Formal PreSchool, CanSkate and Adult skills lessons stop at the end of February. Practices for the annual ice showcase take place during lesson times throughout March.
